1

Sign up for DUI Classes

Go to our [website](#) and download the list of DUI classes providers in your county. When registering, let the school know that it's a volunteer registration and NOT court-ordered, otherwise you will be asked to provide documentation from the court, which you will not have.

2

Add an SR-22 to Your Insurance Policy

Call your existing insurance company and ask about adding an SR-22 to your insurance policy. An SR-22 is typically required for a length of 3 years. Prices may vary, so we encourage you to shop around to get the best quote.

3

Install an IID Breathalyzer In Your Vehicle

In order to reinstate your driving privileges, you will need to have an Ignition Interlock Device (IID) Breathalyzer installed in your vehicle. The average cost is around \$100/month, so we encourage our clients to shop around for this as well.

4

Go to the DMV and Pay Reissue Fee

If your DMV hearing is a loss, you will receive a letter from the DMV notifying you of a pending license suspension. Once the suspension begins, head to the DMV, pay a reissue fee and your driver's license will be reissued on a restricted basis. Now you can legally drive again!
